The manuscript should be written in English, Malay or Arabic and should not exceed 30 pages including diagrams, figures, tables, etc. A manuscript submitted to the journal will be taken to imply that it represents an original unpublished work, not under consideration for publication elsewhere. It should be typewritten with double spacing throughout on the one side of the A4-size paper only using the Garamond font with the font size of 12 for headings (UPPERCASE) and normal text and 10 for footnotes. The first page of the article should contain the title, the name(s) and institutional affiliation(s) of the author(s). All articles will follow a double-blind review by independent consulting editors. The Editorial Board has the right to edit the articles and does not accept responsibility for damage or loss of manuscripts submitted. All published articles may not necessarily be the reflection of KUIM's thoughts, view or stand.

Abstract

Each article should begin with an abstract not exceeding 250 words followed by the keywords of the discussed topic.

Closing Date

Contributions for the second issue should be sent to the Chief Editor before or by **20th February 2006**. For the following issues, contributions could be made on the continuous basis.

Contributor

The contributor should also provide a short background of his/her profile comprising his/her full name, position, organization, academic qualifications, correspondence address, email and research interest.

Contributors should use APA style of referencing.
